A STORY OF GRACE, CALLING, AND CONVICTION

I was raised in an environment with strong morals, but not with a personal relationship with Jesus. It was through my dad, and a Presbyterian church in Southern California, that I first started reading the Bible and asking spiritual questions for myself. That curiosity sparked a journey of searching for truth — and it was through that pursuit that I came to encounter the grace and truth of Jesus Christ in a life-changing way.

In college at UC San Diego, I got involved with InterVarsity Christian Fellowship and began leading Bible studies, mentoring other students, and sharing my faith with classmates. That's where God first broke my heart for others and gave me a passion for discipleship, evangelism, and Scripture.

After nearly a decade in campus ministry, **God expanded my calling** to include the whole church. I wanted to help people not just come to faith, but **grow into lifelong apprentices of Jesus** at every stage of life. That led me to complete my **M.Div. at Fuller Seminary** and begin serving in local church ministry, first as a youth pastor, then as a pastor of adult discipleship and missions, and most recently, as **a house church planter.**

God brought our family to Morgan Hill in 2018, and we've never looked back. This community has become our home — we've put down roots in the schools, neighborhoods, and rhythms of this city. We love it here, and we want to see Morgan Hill flourish in every way — especially spiritually. That's why I'm so excited about what God is doing at Grace Hill. I believe this church is positioned to be a community of grace, a voice of truth, and a place where people of all ages can grow deep in Christ and live out His love in everyday life.



THEOLOGICAL CONVICTIONS AND MINISTRY APPROACH

I affirm the core beliefs of historic Christianity as expressed in the Apostles' and Nicene Creeds, and I joyfully and fully align with the Essential Tenets and Constitution of ECO, our denomination. I believe in the one true and living God — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — and in the gospel of Jesus Christ as the only Savior and Lord. My theology is deeply shaped by the Reformed tradition, with its rich emphasis on God's sovereignty, the authority of Scripture, the centrality of grace, and the transformation of the whole person in Christ.

At the heart of my ministry is a belief that **the Bible is God's authoritative, living Word,** and it must shape everything we do as a church. I love helping people read the Bible in a way that brings it to life — connecting its truth to their everyday experience, and showing how God's Word is meant to stir our hearts, sharpen our minds, and transform our lives.

I also believe that **discipleship** is not something we tack on to the edges of life — it's a whole new identity and way of being. **Following Jesus is a lifelong journey of formation.** My approach to ministry emphasizes **spiritual practices, intentional relationships, and rhythms of grace** that help us live with God at the center.

A framework I often use in both personal and church life is this:

- Sacred Word How do we see the world? Through the lens of Scripture.
- Sacred Time How do we move through the world? Through rhythms of rest, worship, service, and formation both daily and across the Christian calendar.
- Sacred Space Who is on the journey with us, and how do we create spaces of transformation? Whether in our homes, our worship gatherings, or our city, we are called to create environments where people encounter Christ and become more like Him.

I believe Grace Hill has everything it needs to be this kind of community — and I look forward to pursuing that vision with you, prayerfully and joyfully, in the years to come.
